

BREAKING NEWS UPDATE: Fire on Woods End Lane

THURSDAY, 7:30AM: Weston firefighters battled a house fire Wednesday, March 28, at 6 Woods End Lane, off Godfrey Road East near the transfer station. Godfrey Road East was closed to through traffic from about 1:30 until 4:15 p.m.

Weston firefighter Mark Blake reported the Weston Volunteer Fire Department responded to the scene at 1:30. When they arrived, one wing of the house was fully involved with flames.

"First arriving units found heavy smoke and fire issuing from the roof of the house. It was initially reported that there were people trapped in the house, however the occupants and their pets were quickly accounted for unharmed," Mr. Blake said. "The fire was brought under control within an hour of the first arriving engine. However, the house suffered heavy smoke and fire damage. There were no injuries to civilians or firefighters."

Weston was assisted by the Wilton and Georgetown fire departments.

Both the Weston fire marshal and the state fire marshal are investigating the fire.
